The Marianne Fell Rudman Award

Established by Marianne's husband, sisters, and parents to honor the memory of Marianne by recognizing an outstanding senior girl who exemplifies the well-rounded, caring nature for which Marianne is remembered. A graduate of HPHS, Marianne died in 1974. Each spring, nominations are taken from students and faculty. Then after a preliminary screening, 5-6 senior girls are interviewed by a committee of faculty members and a final choice is made.

2. *A loving relationship with her family*

6. *Thoughtfulness and consideration of the needs of others*
7. *Persistence in the face of obstacles*
8. *Scholarly attainment (upper half of graduating class)*
