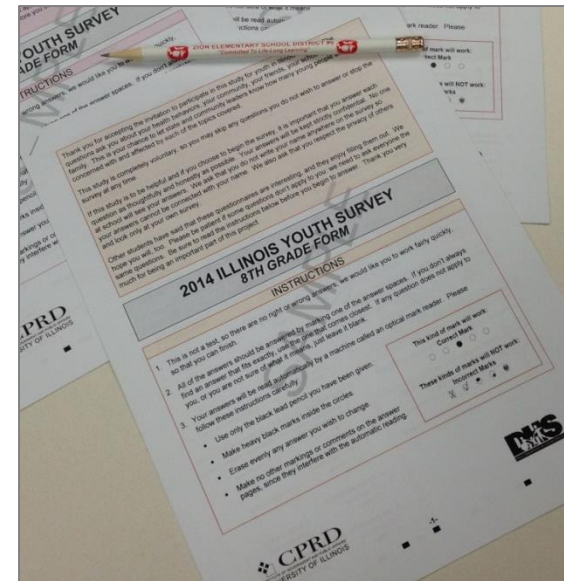

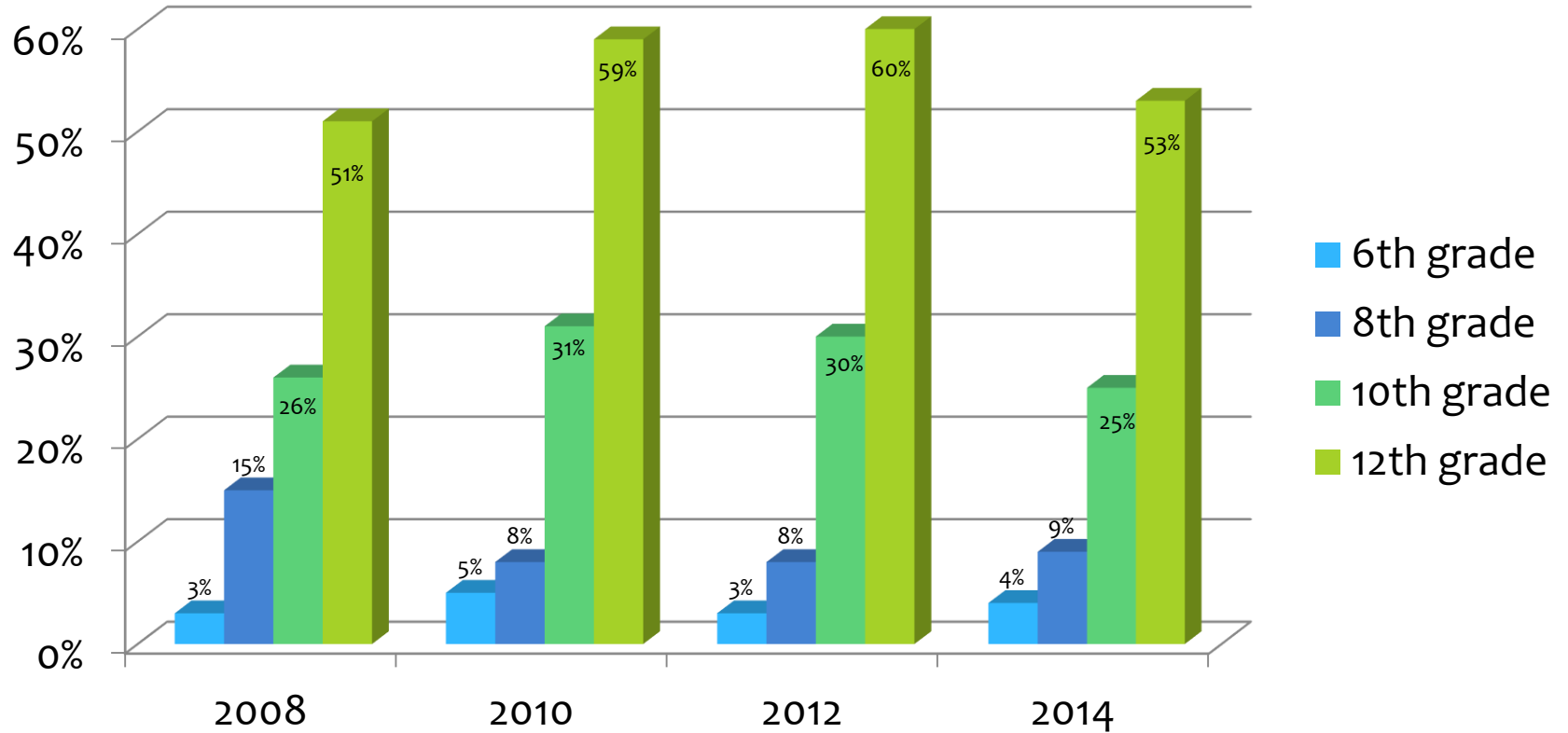

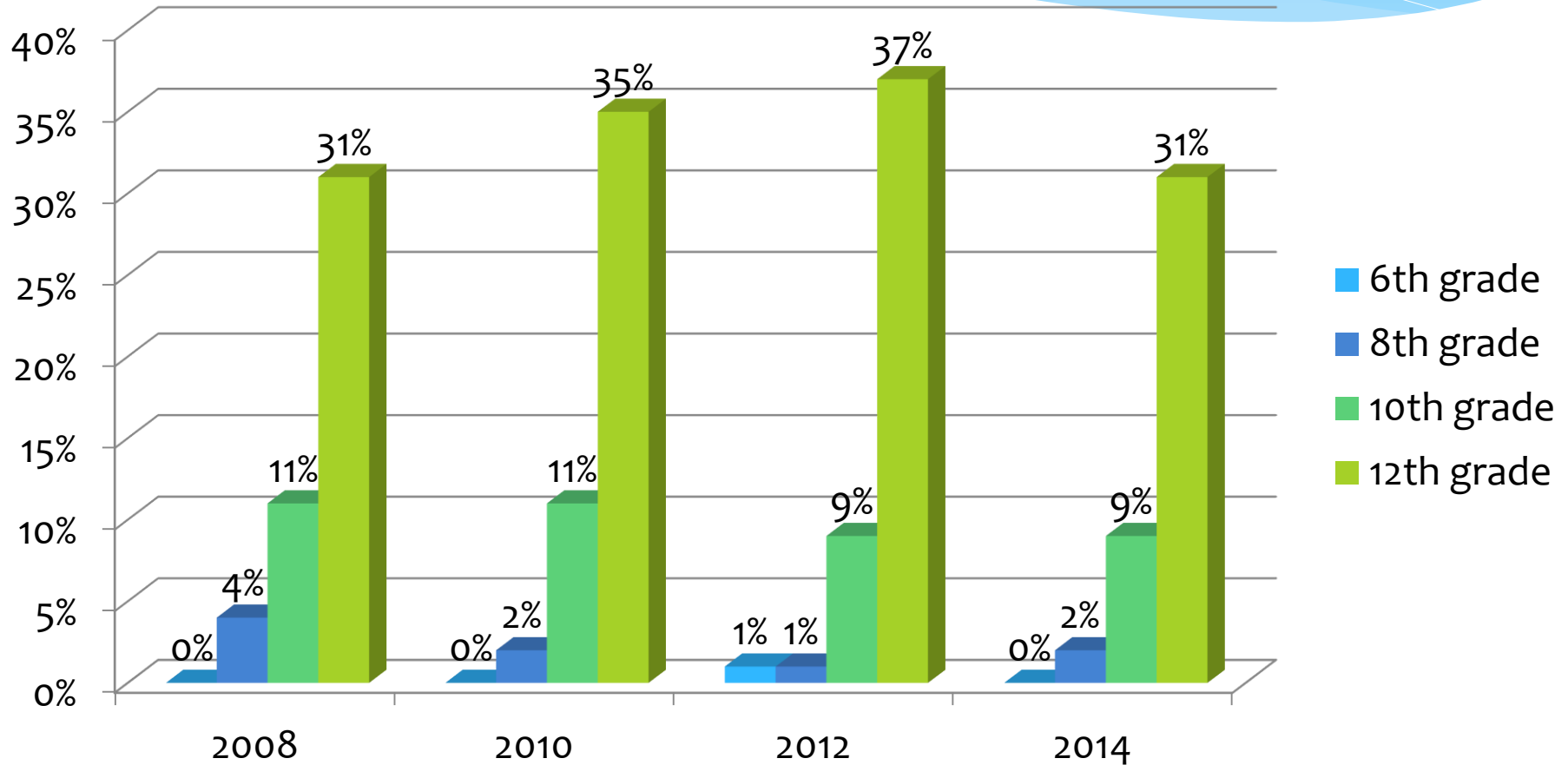

Binge Drinking – Past Two Weeks

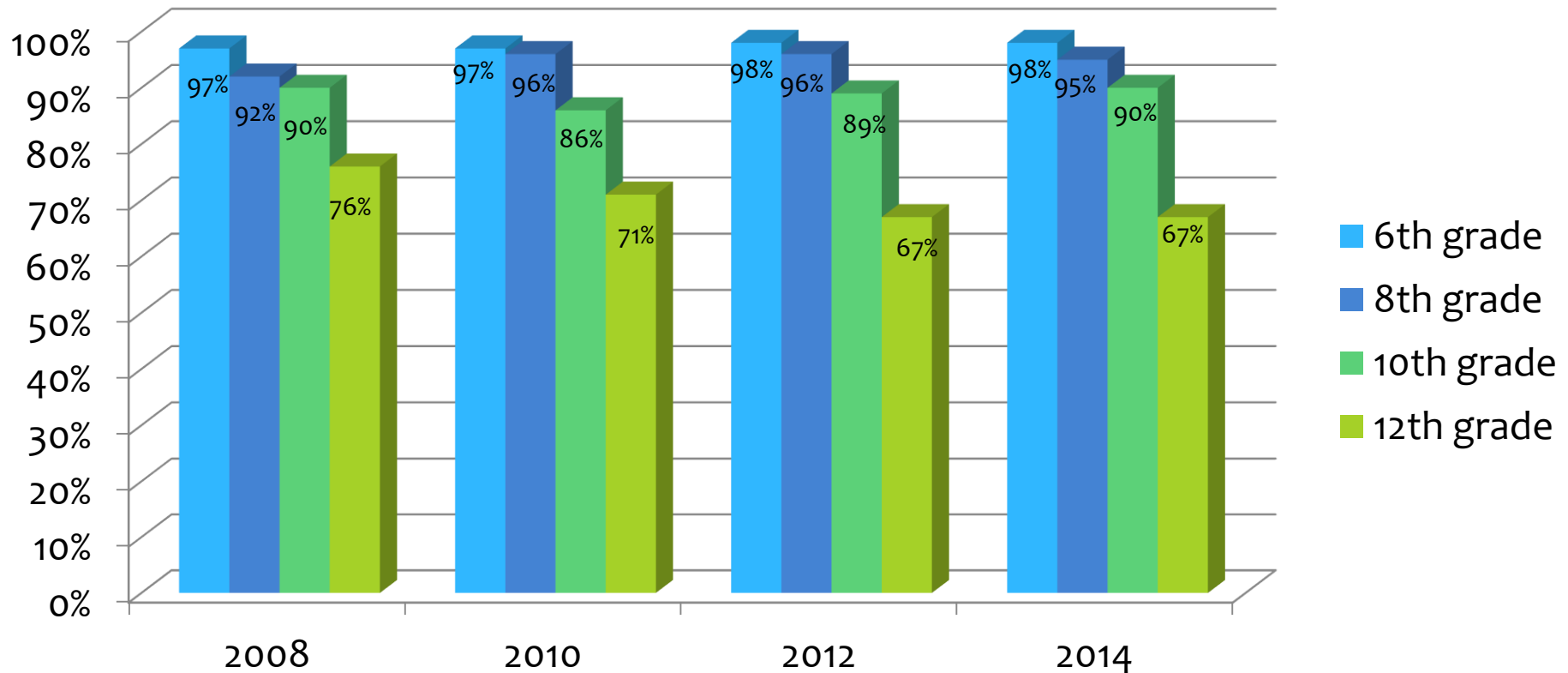

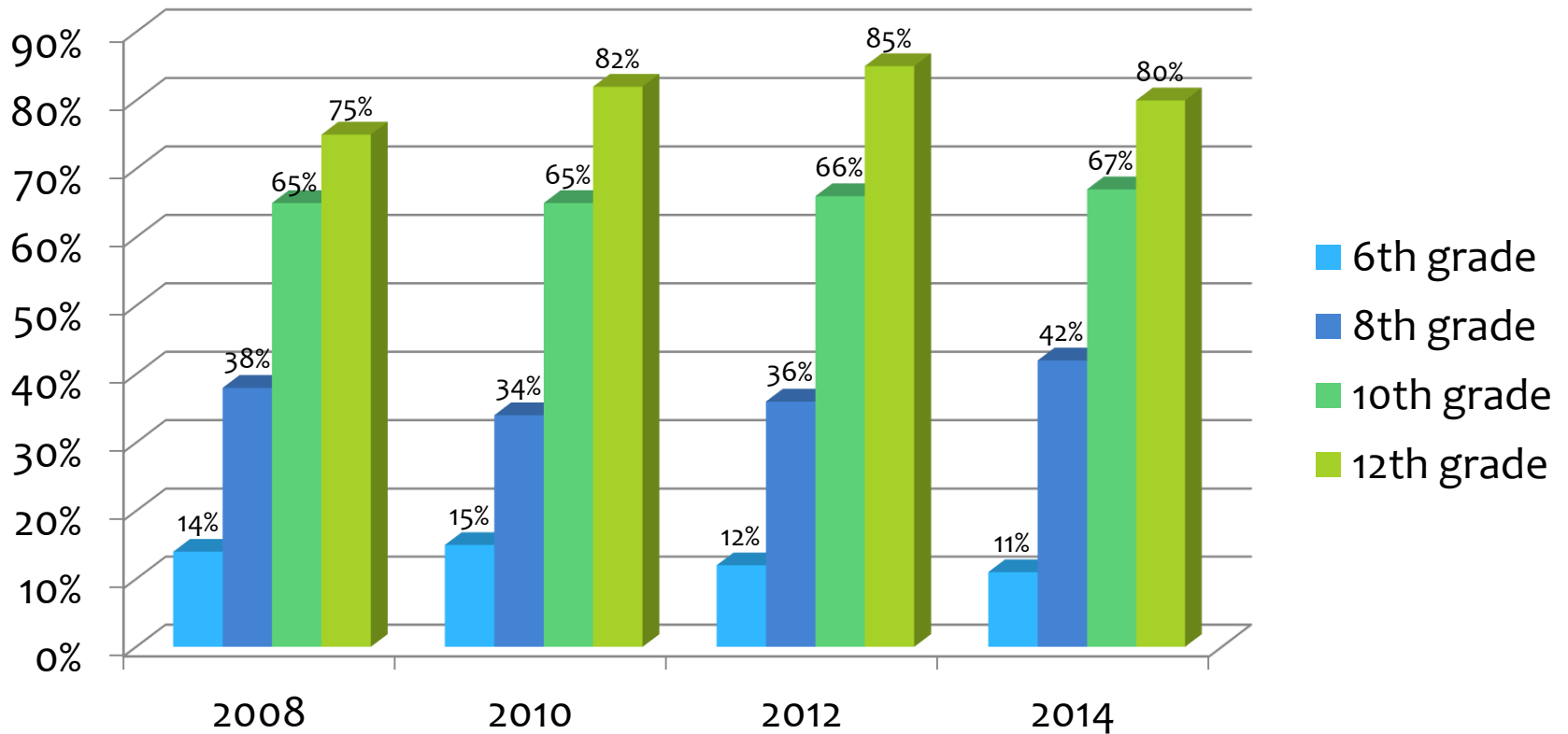

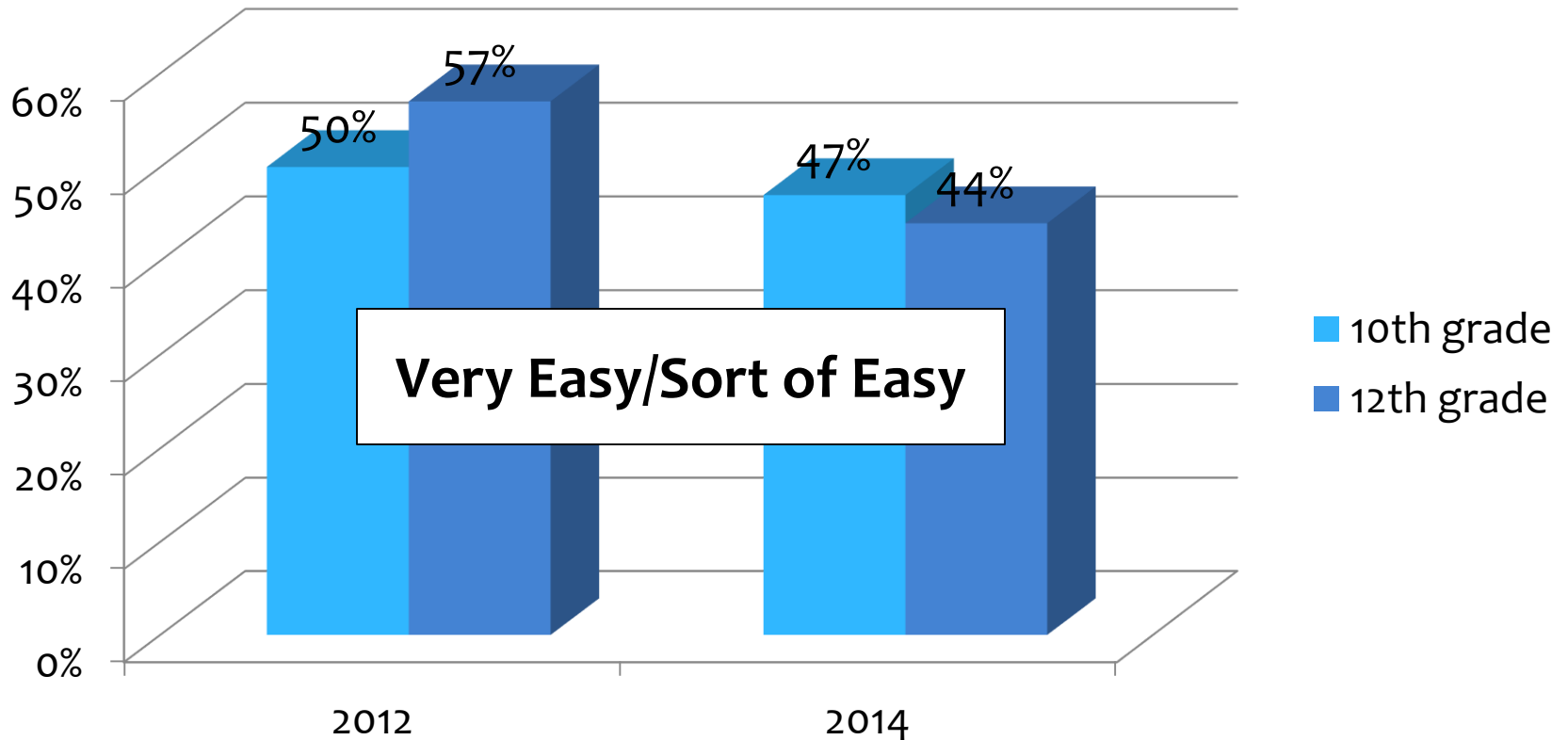

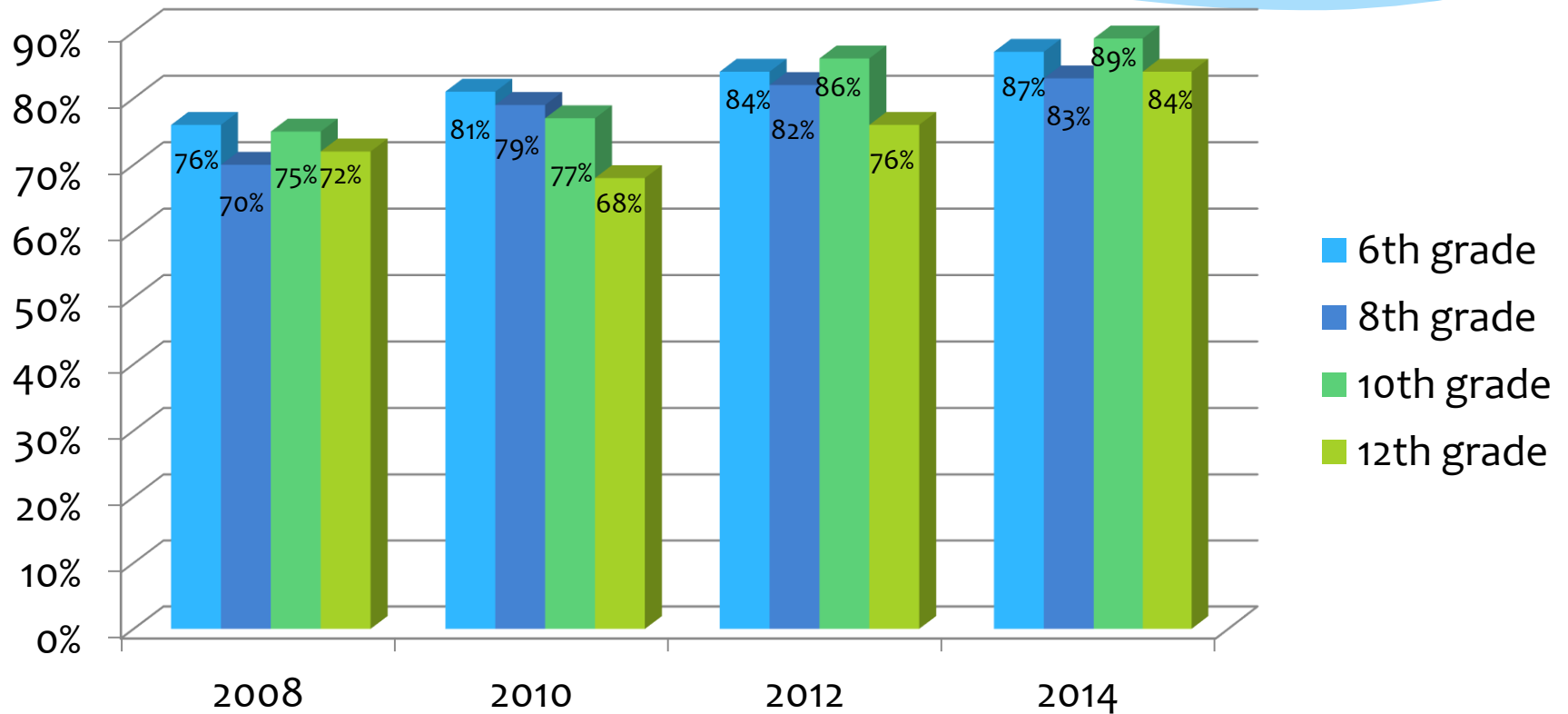

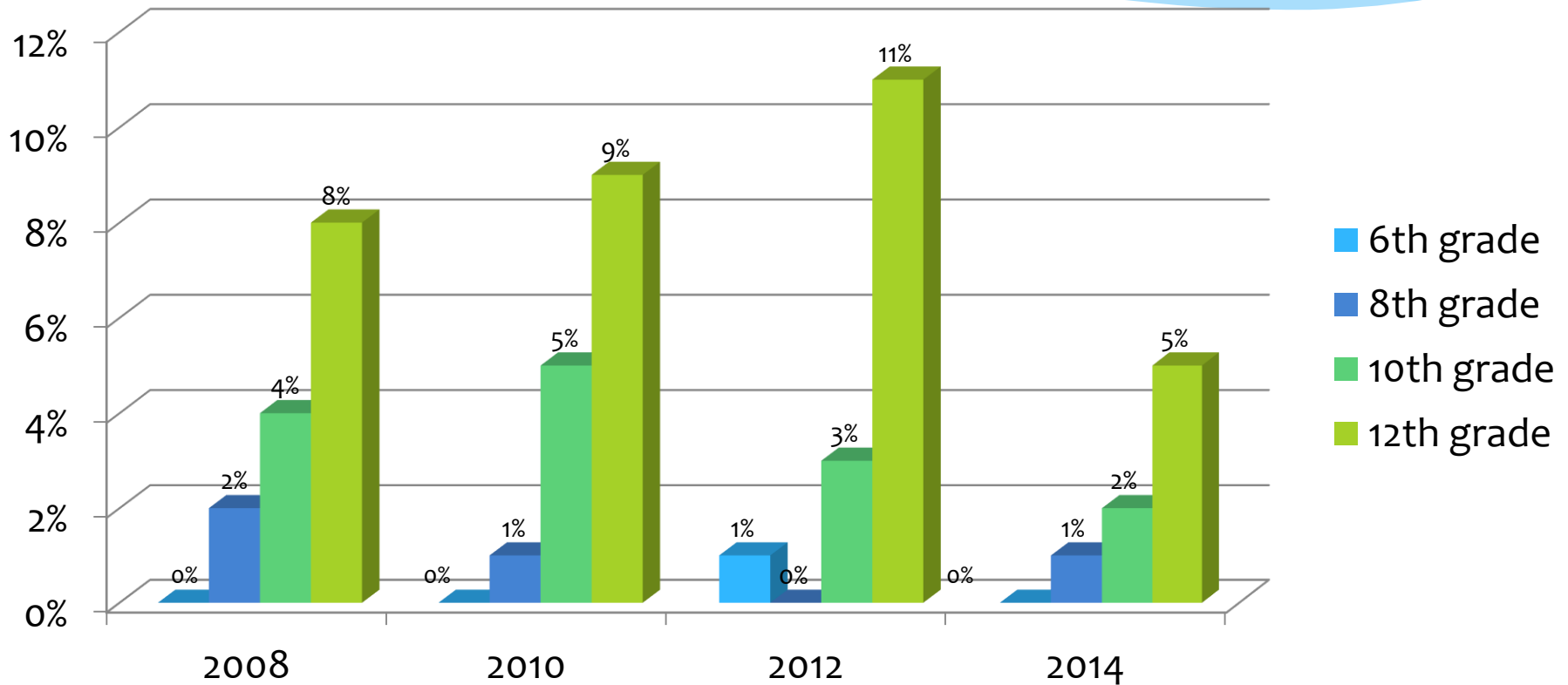

Cigarette Use— Past 30 Days

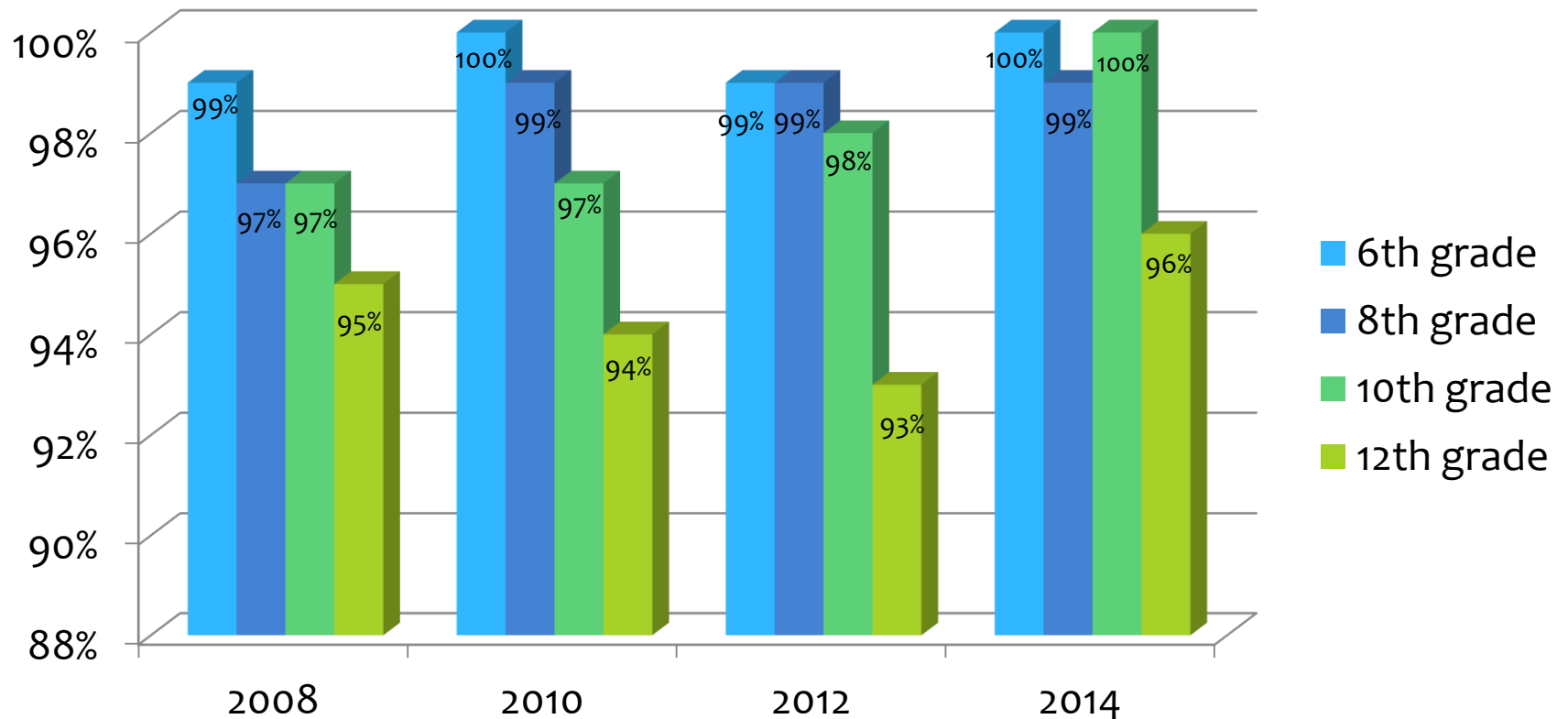

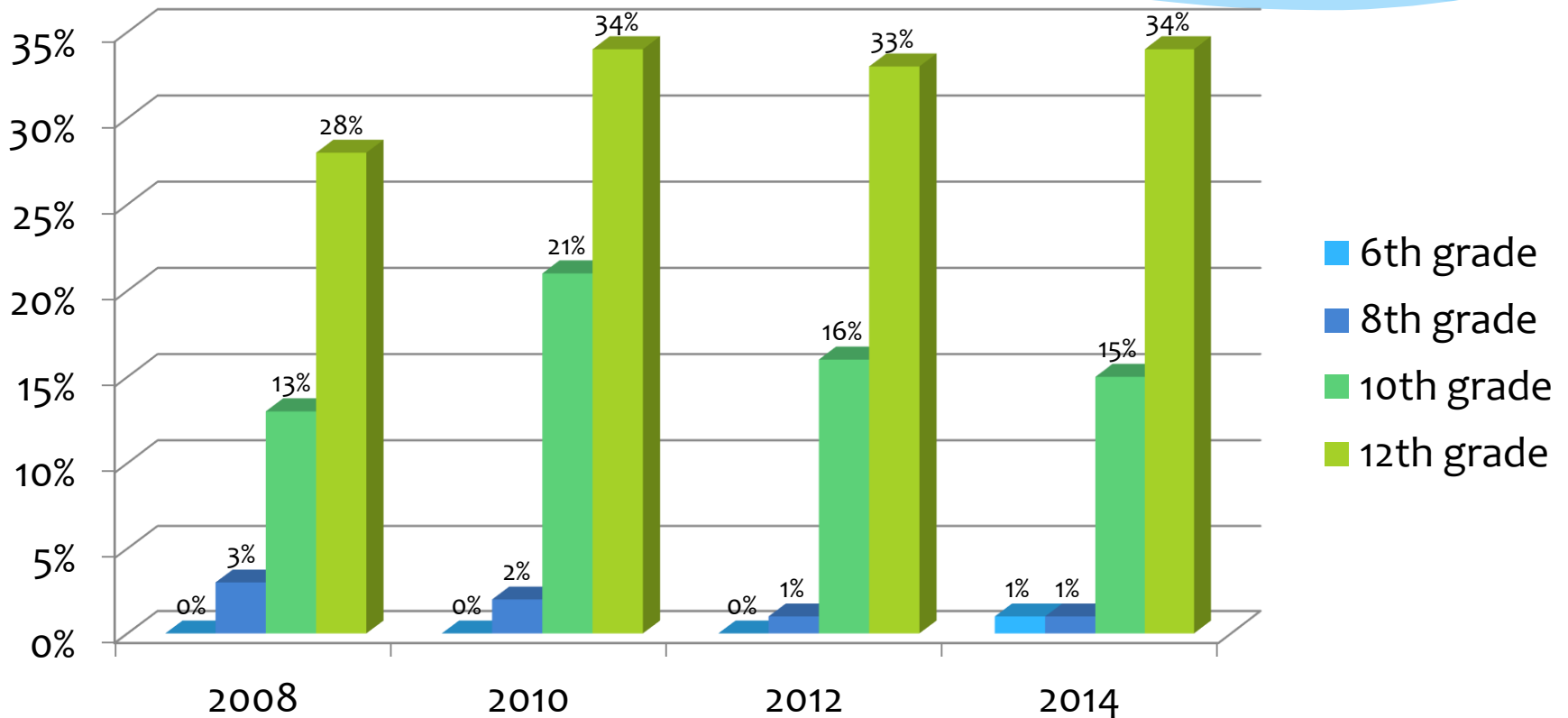

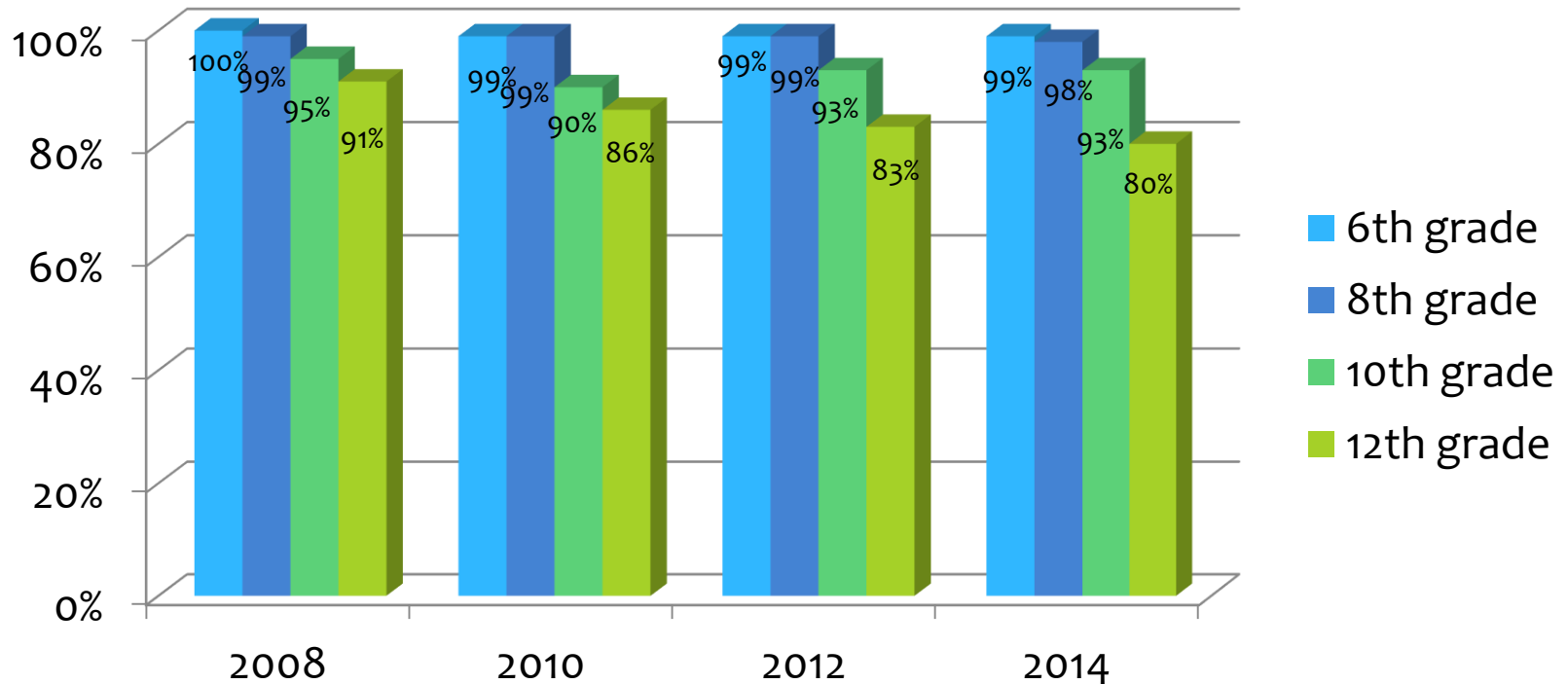

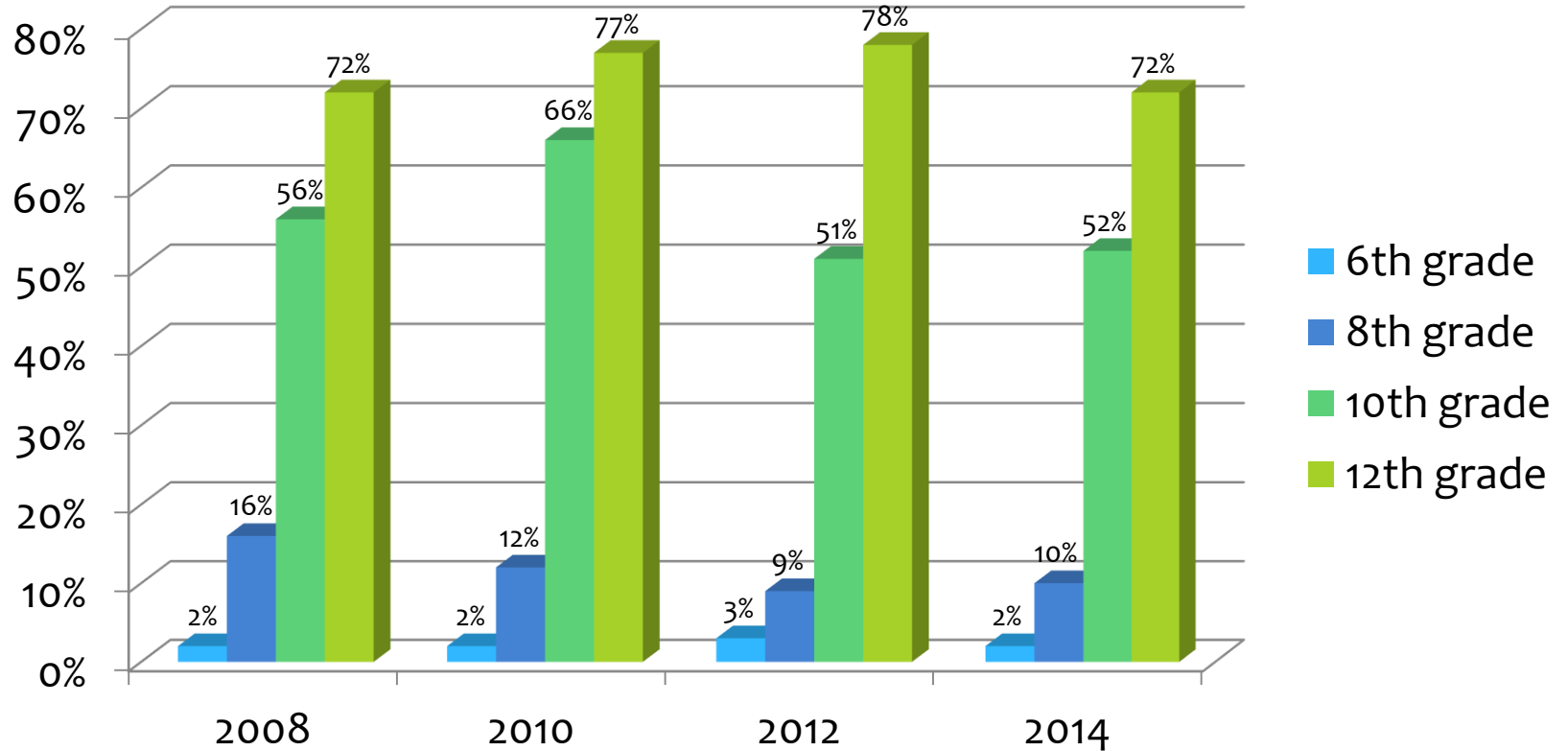

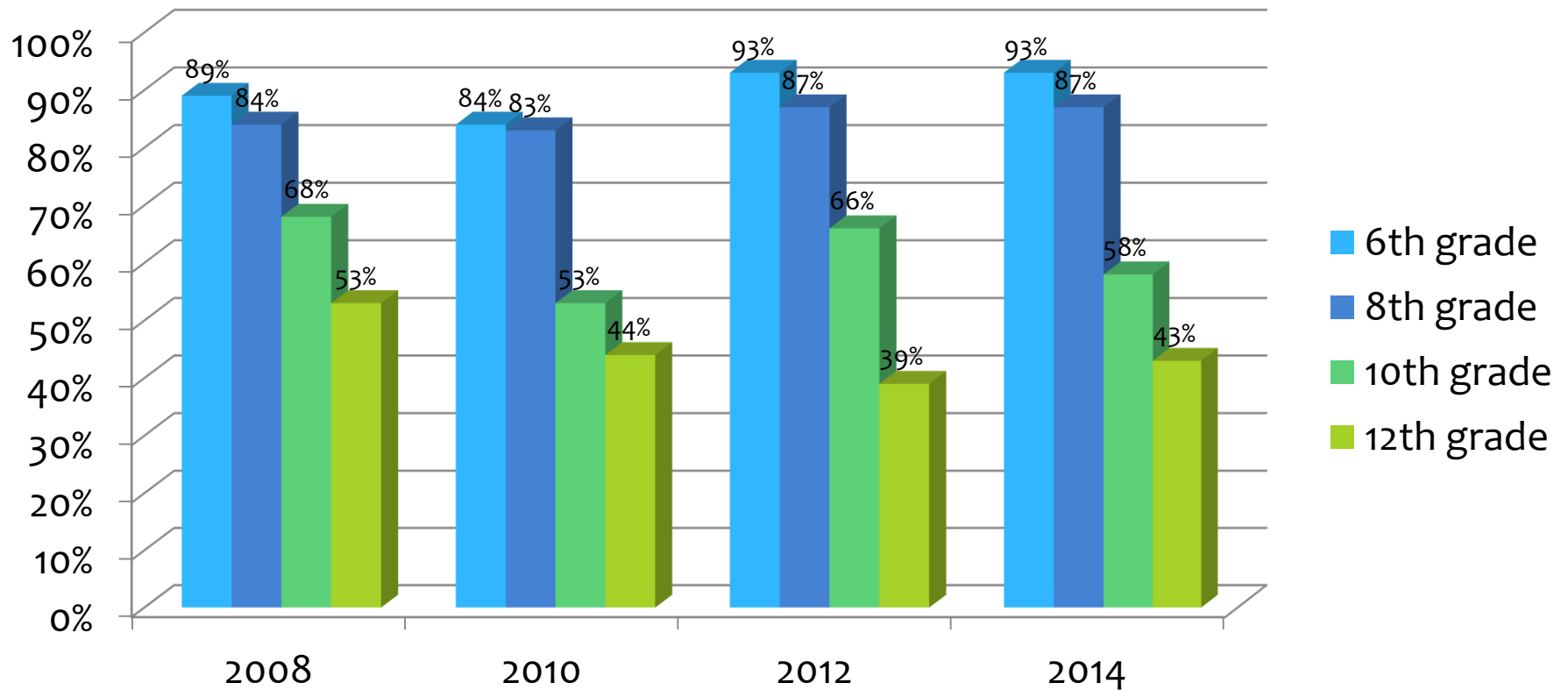

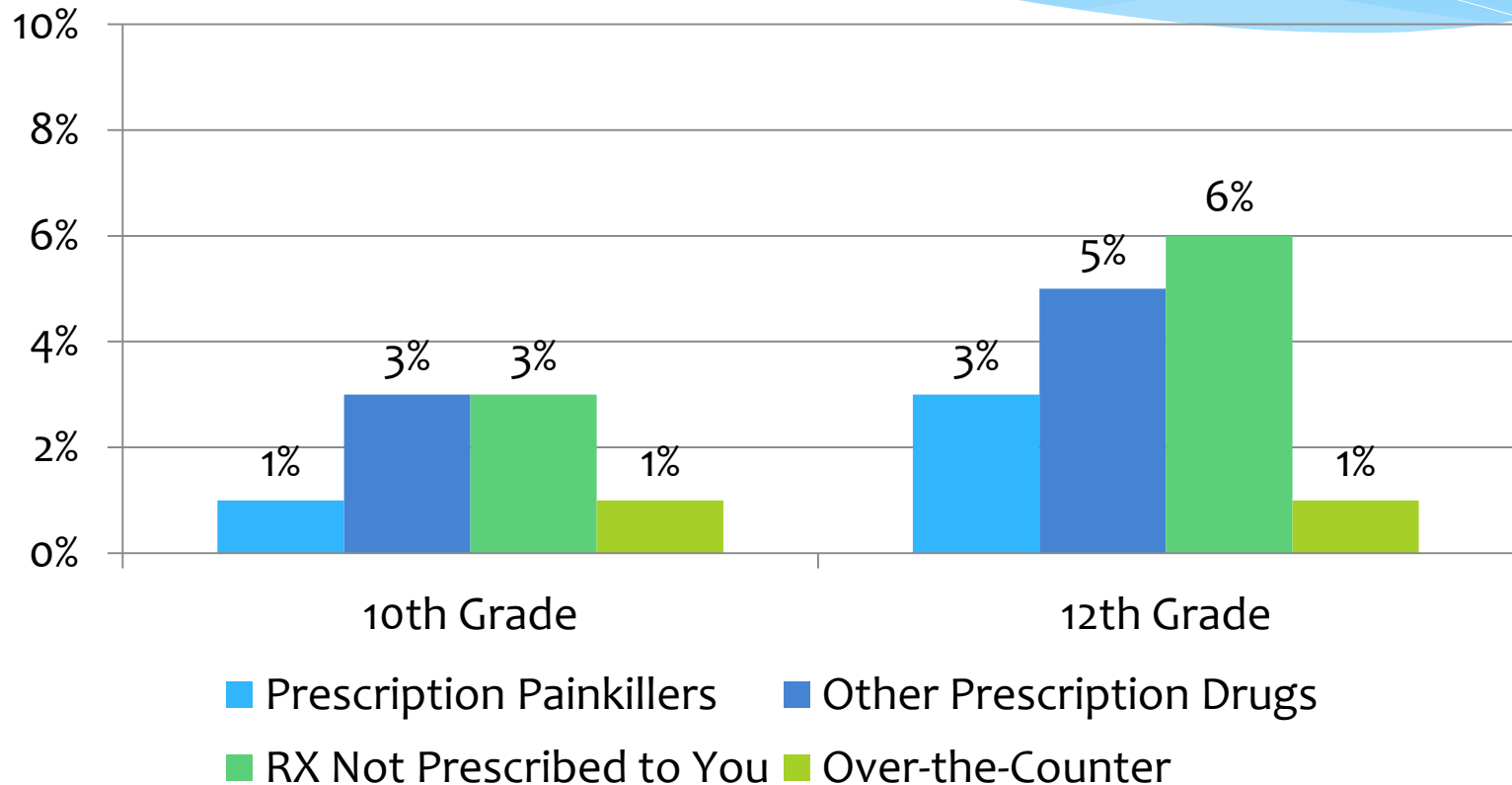

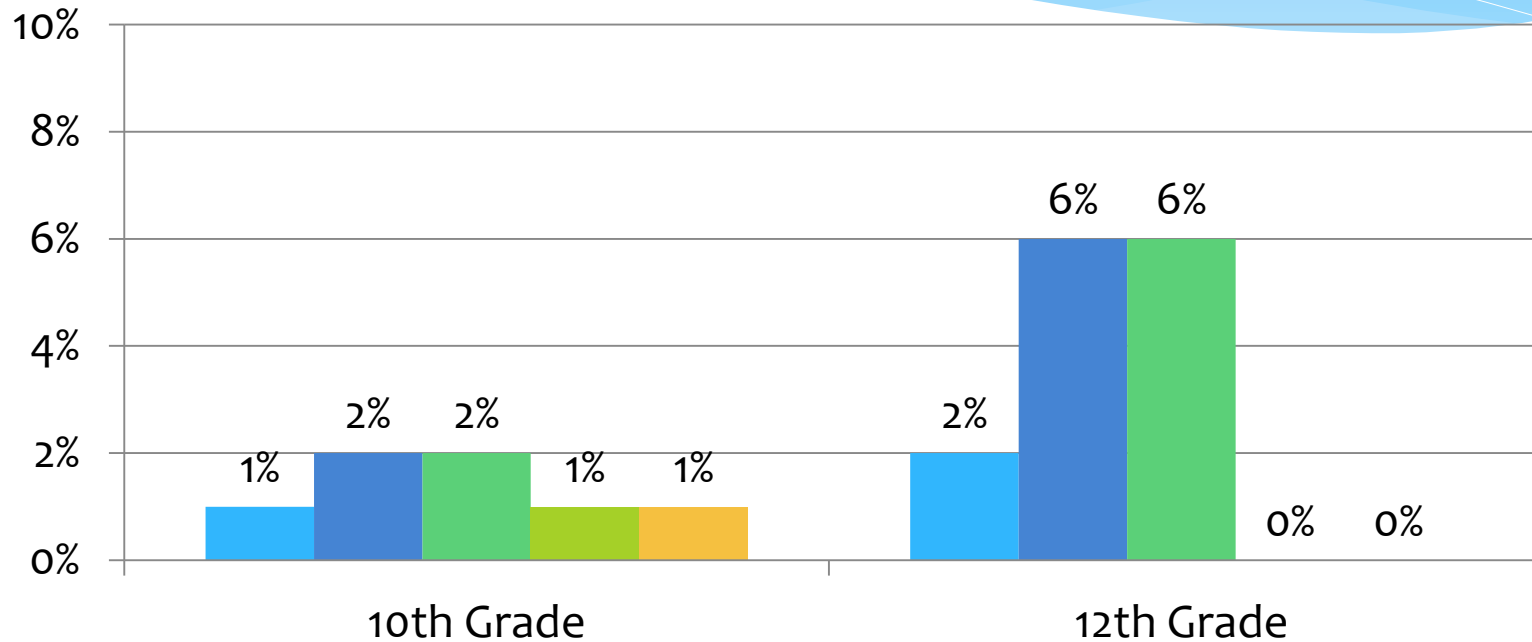


Prescription & OTC Drugs – Past 30 Days

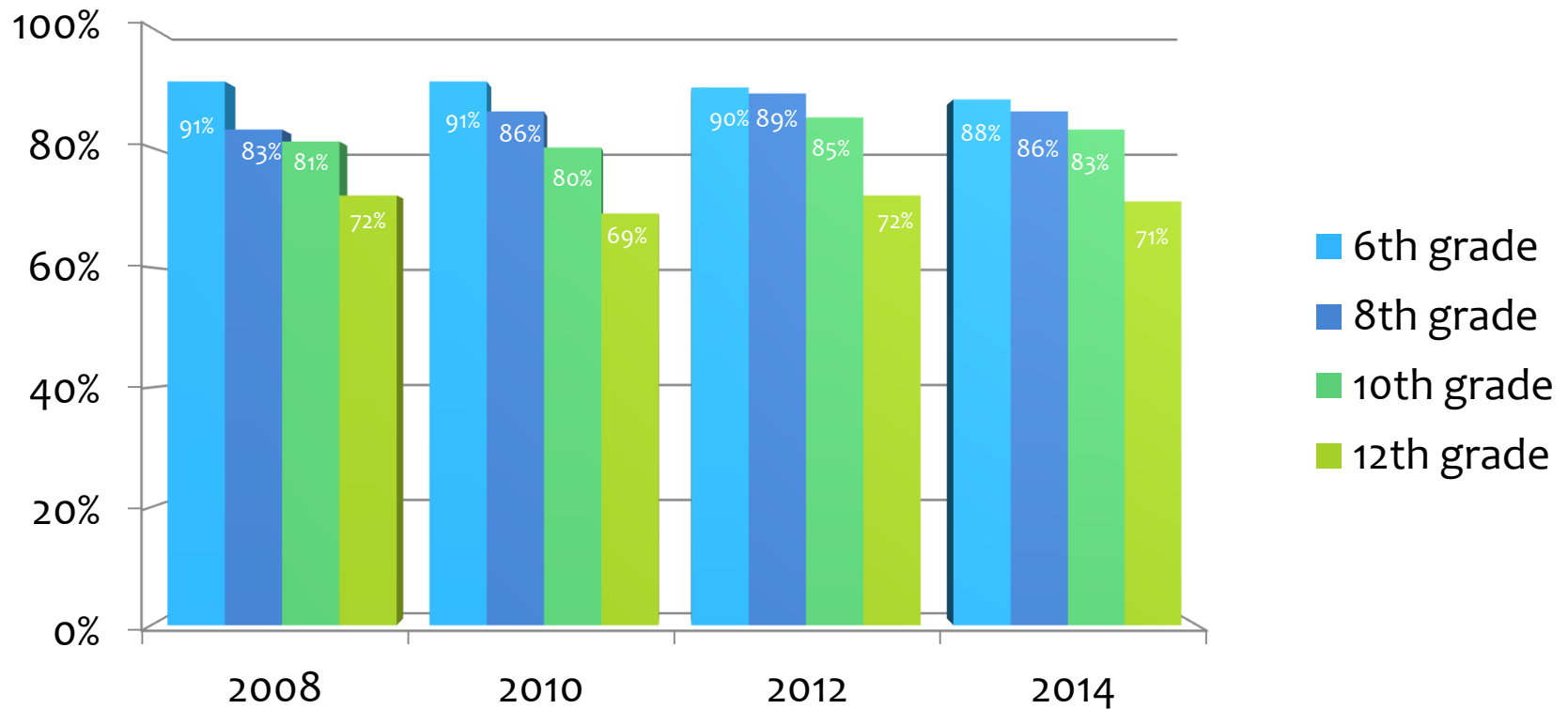

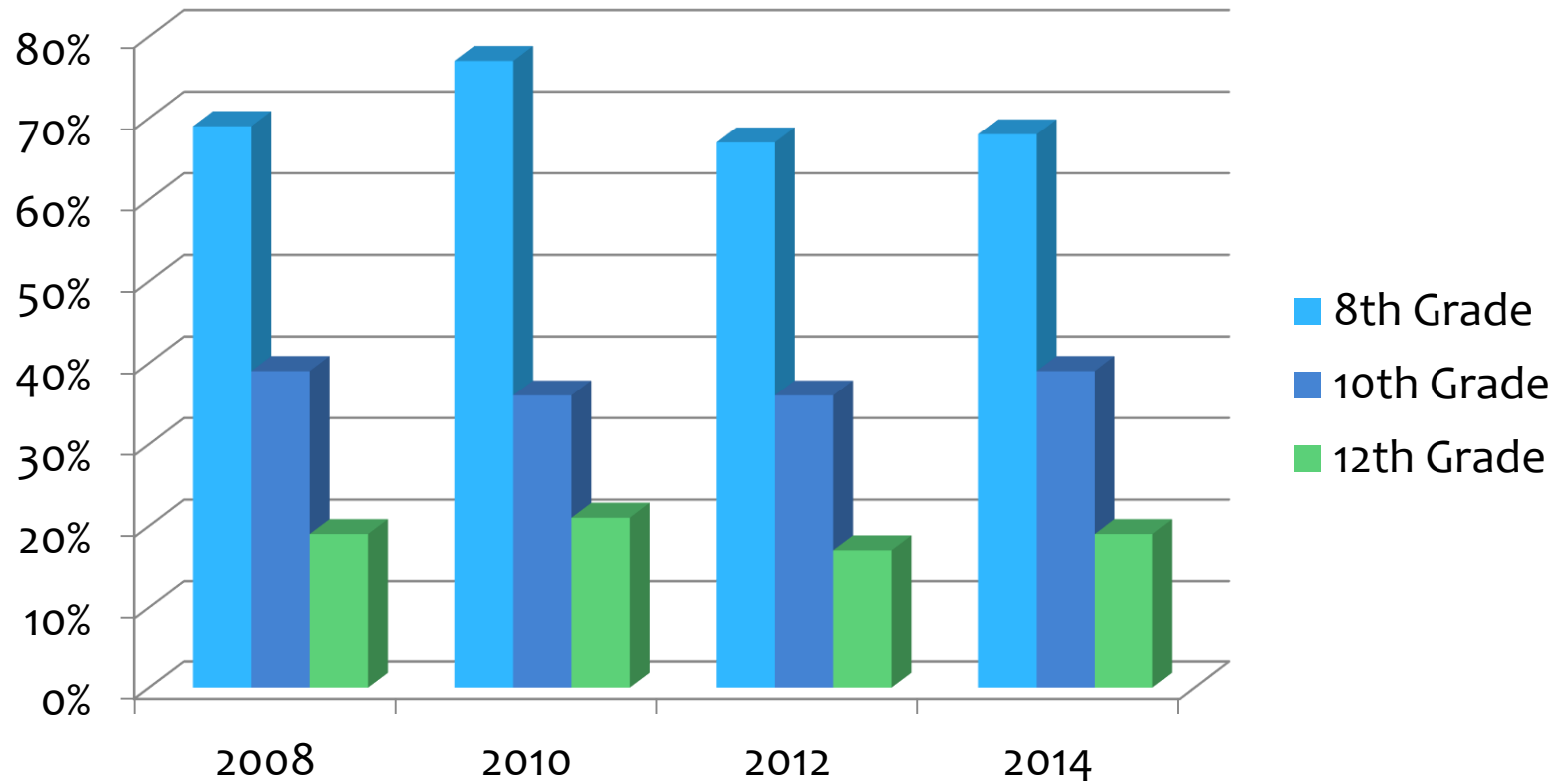

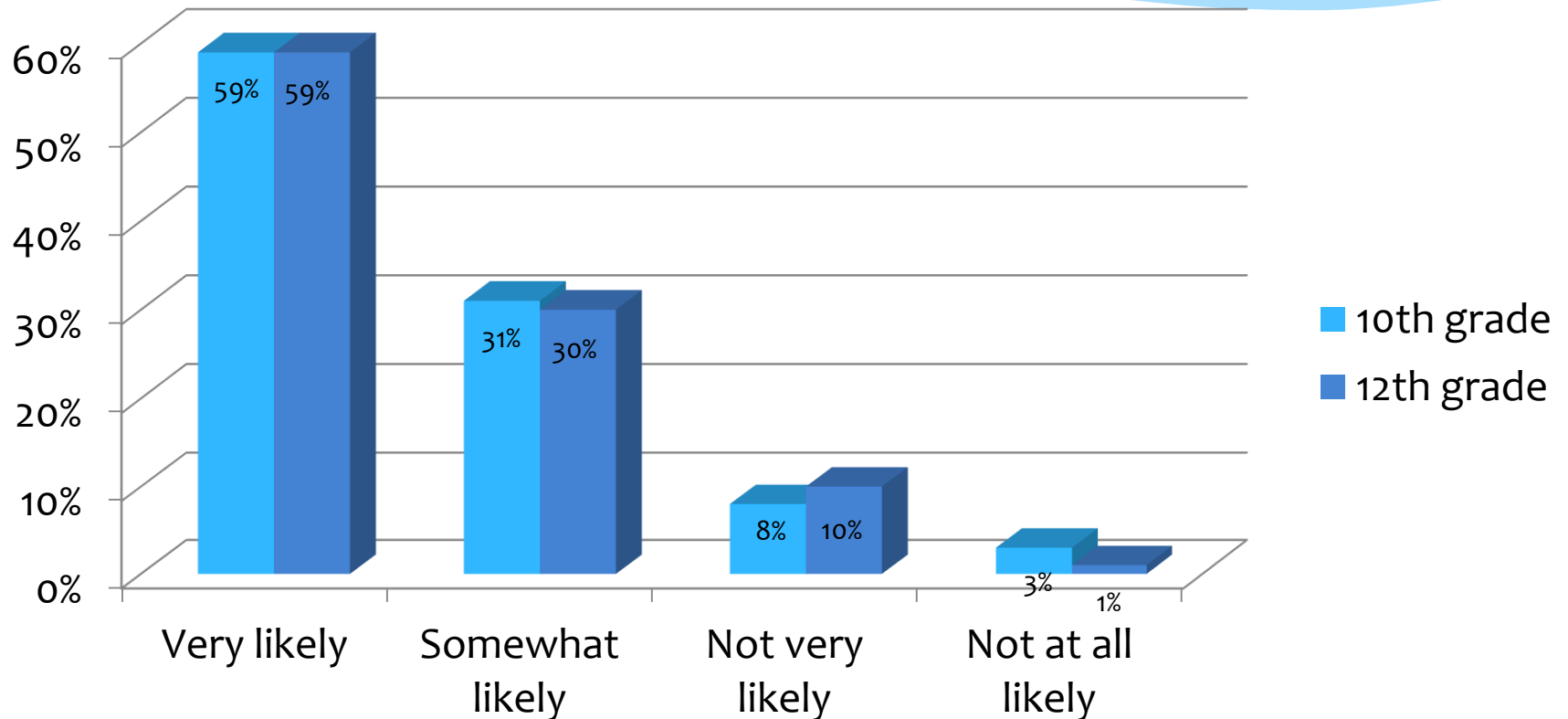


If you witness bullying in school or cyberbullying, how likely are you to tell an adult about it? 2014 Exta Questions
