

2:230-TR – Temporary Rules for Public Participation at School Board Meetings During COVID-19 Emergency

For the duration of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Administration building will be closed to the public but Board meetings will be available to the public to watch and hear online. Anyone who wishes to watch the meeting should go to <https://www.dist113.org/domain/992> to see it in English or Spanish. Members of the public without access to sufficient technology to access the meeting may contact the administration in advance of the meeting to request appropriate accommodations.

Anyone who wishes to share a comment with the Board during the Public Comments portion of the meeting can do so by calling a phone number circulated by the District in advance of the meeting and leaving a message to be played during Public Comment. The time for leaving messages will be circulated in advance. Only messages left at the specified number during the specified time will be played, and messages will be limited to three minutes. Please note that *Policy 2-230 Public Participation at School Board Meetings and Petitions to the Board* applies to all comments, including identifying oneself. Anonymous messages will not be played. The Board President will play as many of these comments as time allows and they will be incorporated into meeting minutes as usual. The Board President may decide to restrict the total time for comments to 30 minutes.
