CONCERT PAPER ASSIGNMENT

Once a quarter*, you are to attend a concert of classical or jazz music or a performance of musical theatre. This performance may be by a professional, college or high school group. A list of concerts occurring during any given quarter will be announced or posted in the band room. After attending the performance, you are to type a one to two-page paper discussing the event.

Topics to be covered should include:

What, where and when of the event

Descriptions of two or three pieces performed

<u>Evaluation</u> of the performance (what did they do well and what needed work)

<u>Summary</u> of what you learned from the performance

This paper will be averaged into the musicology portion of your grade. It is due within one week of the performance attended, but no later than the due dates listed below. If possible, please attach a program from the performance. If you are in more than one band, you do not need to write more than one paper. You may not write about a concert in which you are performing.

*The assigned quarters for completing the concert papers are as follows:

Freshmen: 1st, 2nd and 3rd. Sophomores: 2nd, 3rd and 4th. Juniors: 1st, 2nd and 4th. Seniors: 1st and 3rd. Jazz Band members not in another band: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th

Due dates: 1st, 2nd and 3rd quarters, last day of the quarter. 4th quarter, the Friday before the last week of the quarter.
