Dear Parents/Guardians of sophomores,

**On Wednesday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, at 8:00 AM** all sophomore students at Highland Park High School will take the PSAT 10 for 10<sup>th</sup> graders. The PSAT 10 tests the same skills and knowledge as the SAT. The PSAT 10 also establishes a measurement of a student's college and career readiness.

Students should arrive at school on Wednesday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, by 7:45 a.m. for the test and report to their assigned test location. There will be a different bus schedule on this day. Check the website for more information. Test location assignments for students will be posted outside the Deans'/Attendance Office and at the Main and H entrances in the afternoon on Tuesday, April 4<sup>th</sup>. Students testing with accommodations will receive a separate letter providing more information for test time, room, and accommodations.

Students are allowed to use calculators including the TI-Nspire CAS. HPHS will not provide them for those who come without. Students must bring a picture ID, #2 pencils (**non-mechanical**) and a calculator (check the batteries).

Information about obtaining test results will be shared by the Counseling Department at a later date.

There are no classes on April 5<sup>th</sup>. Juniors will take the SAT with essay and sophomore students take the PSAT 10. Freshmen and seniors are not in attendance. Students will be dismissed after their respective test is over. The standard PSAT will end at approximately 11:45 AM.
