Dear Parents/Guardians of junior students:

Highland Park High School will administer the SAT with essay to all juniors on Wednesday, April 5<sup>th</sup>. The SAT is now a graduation requirement for all Illinois high school students in the class of 2018 so we encourage you to ensure your child is in attendance on this day.

Students should arrive at school on Wednesday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, by 7:45 a.m. for the test and report to their assigned test location. There will be a different bus schedule on this day. Check the website for more information. Test location assignments for students will be posted outside the Deans'/Attendance Office and at the Main and H entrances in the afternoon on Tuesday, April 4<sup>th</sup>. Students testing with accommodations will receive a separate letter providing more information for test time, room and accommodations.

Students are allowed to use calculators including the TI-Nspire CAS. HPHS will not provide them for those who come without. Students must bring a picture ID, #2 pencils (**non-mechanical**) and a calculator (check the batteries).

There are no classes on April 5<sup>th</sup>. Juniors will take the SAT with essay and sophomore students take the PSAT 10. Freshmen and seniors are not in attendance. Students will be dismissed after their respective test is over. The standard SAT test will end at approximately 1:15 PM.
