

### **Important information for Juniors about the SAT with Essay make-up test**

Junior students who did not take the SAT test on April 5<sup>th</sup> are required to take the make-up test. Details below are for the standard test and students who test with accommodations.

Highland Park High School has scheduled a make-up day for the standard SAT with Essay on Tuesday, April 25<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 a.m. in room A343. Students need to report to room A343 no later than 7:50 a.m. to take the make-up exam. Students should bring their HPHS student I.D., two #2 pencils (non-mechanical) and a calculator. Students are allowed to use the TI-Nspire CAS. Students may bring snacks to eat during breaks. The test will end approximately 1:15PM. Students will be excused from classes for the duration of the test. The regular bus schedule will run on this day.

Junior students who receive accommodations for the SAT with Essay will take the make-up test on Monday April 17<sup>th</sup> and/or Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>. Some students will test on both days. A letter with detailed information has been mailed. Students need to report no later than 7:50 a.m. to the room indicated in the letter received about the make-up exam. Students should bring their HPHS student I.D., two #2 pencils (non-mechanical) and a calculator. Students are allowed to use the TI-Nspire CAS. Students may bring snacks to eat during breaks. If you have any questions, please check in the Special Education Department A102 or the Assistant Principals' Office A233. Students will be excused from classes for the duration of the test. The regular bus schedules will run on both of these days.
