Fund Balances, to a district, can be viewed as savings or checking account balances to the average citizen. A ratio of .25 or greater scores 4, between .25 and .10 scores 3, between .10 and zero scores 2 and a negative fund balance to revenue ratio scores 1.

The Expenditure to Revenue Ratio represents how much the school district is spending for every dollar they are bringing in as revenue. Equal to or less than \$1.00 has a score of 4, between \$1.00 and \$1.10 scores 3, between \$1.10 and \$1.20 scores 2 and spending of greater than \$1.20 scores 1. One-time expenditures made by the district, including construction costs, are included in this ratio. Upon review of the remaining fund balance when deficit spending occurs, the indicator score may be adjusted.



Long-Term Debt Amount




### Fund Balance to Revenue Ratio

### Days Cash on Hand



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
