I. Required Materials

- A perforated notebook or binder to take notes and keep homework in an organized order.
- **Use pencil** on everything. Have a TI-Inspire CX CAS calculator and a **red pen** to self-correct problems.
- It is recommended you keep your notes, handouts, quizzes, and homework in a math only folder.
- *Geometry* by Bass, Charles, Johnson, and Kennedy (Prentice Hall)

II. Grades and Targets

- Semester Grade: 90% Assessments; 10% Homework located on Schoology
- Overall semester grade = $0.80(\text{semester grade}) + 0.20(\text{Final Exam grade})$



III. Daily Homework

- The homework assignment guide for each chapter will be located on the Materials section on Schoology.
- Title each assignment by date, section, page, and problem numbers. Students need to show **all** of their work and attempt **all** problems for homework.
- Correct your homework problems using **red pen**. Homework solutions, etc. are created for every chapter and are located on the Google site located on Schoology. Daily homework checks for completion will occur. Students will earn 2/2 if **both** the work and correct answers are shown **with** corrections. Students will earn 1 point for more than half finished and 0 for anything less. If you are absent you are expected to make up the missed homework check when you return. Late assignments will not be accepted.

IV. Absentee Makeup Policies and Consequences

- Communicate prearranged absences to the teacher **in advance** to establish a plan for missed days. You should take a missed quiz or test prior to your absence so plan accordingly.
- Students have up to “ $x + 1$ ” school days to make up a test or quiz in the Makeup Test Center, where x is the number of days missed. Failure to do so may result in a penalty of 10%. An alternative makeup assessment will be given. Students with absences the day before a quiz/test will take the quiz/test on the scheduled date.



VI. Behavior & Consequences

- Be in your seat when the bell rings. Detentions will be issued for 3 or more tardies in a quarter.
- Any work involving academic dishonesty the school handbook will be consulted.
- Borrowing a calculator from the teacher will result in 2 points deducted on the assessment.
- Absences need to be authorized via the school attendance policy.
- With various concerns that may arise, the school handbook will be consulted and utilized when appropriate. All consequences are determined by the teacher and given at his discretion.
- Food is not permitted, and plastic drinks/water bottles with caps will be. Coffee & glass bottles are not permitted.
- Earbuds need to be put away out of sight.
- Students will need to **turn off** their phones and **place** the phone in a backpack as they enter class. If a student refuses to do so and the phone is out in plain sight and is a distraction during class a Referral to the Dean’s Office will result in a detention and your parents will be contacted.
