The admissions process has two components: (1) the completion and submission of this application form and (2) confirmation of the applicant's character by at least six teachers. The confirmation of character process is outlined in the notification email all eligible students receive. The application form must be submitted to Mr. Wolf, Honor Society sponsor, in the appropriate box in E117. Any additional forms must be stapled to this application. **Applications are due by the end of the school day on Friday, March 6, 2020. No late applications will be accepted.**

To qualify, a student must have a minimum of 10 extracurricular points. Points are earned by participating in a DHS sponsored extracurricular activity (activities that qualify are listed below). The charts list each qualified extra-curricular and the number of points which can be earned each season or year. In addition, a student serving as an officer or captain of an extra-curricular activity will earn one extra point per season or year. Participation in an activity or class in which a student receives a grade **does not** count for extracurricular points.

Students may earn a **maximum of 3 points** towards the necessary 10 points for community service activities/projects. These activities/projects must be on-going during the school year or can be concentrated during a school break. Examples of this would be Scouts, Habitat for Humanity, or religious work. Each community service activity/project earns 1 point per year. The sponsor for such service work must submit a verification letter. This letter must have the student's name on the letter, along with a description of the service activity/project, hours spent working on service and the dates of service. Form letters without a student's name, a description of service work or dates of service will not be accepted.

2 point activities per year: Anime Club, ARC Tutors, Art Club, Cheer Squad, Chess Club, Christian Club, Coding Club, Computer Club, DASA, DECA, Deerprints, Delta, DHS Film & TV, Earthworks, Executive Boards, Fashion Club, Feminist Club, Fencing Club, GEM, GIMA, Girls Coding, Human Rights Club, Israel Club, Jazz Lab Band, Key Club, Marching Band, Mathletes, Medical Careers Club, Model United Nations, Monday/Tuesday Afternoon Jazz, OYAD, Peer Helping, Philosophy Club, Political Club, Robotics, Scholastic Bowl, Science Club, Snowball, SOS, Spectrum, Stage Crew, STEM Club, Student Congress, Student Council, Theatrix, Troubadour, Varsity Club, Warrior Buddies, Warrior Dance Team, Warrior Hockey, WYSE.

1 point activities per year: Assistant Director (for theater productions), Book Club, Chinese Honor Society, CSL Leadership Conference, Dance Company, French Honor Society, Global Glimpse, Hebrew Honor Society, Investment Club, Legal Aid Clinic Club, Mosaic, Movie Club, Optimist Club, Principal's Student Advisory Board, Rotary Club, Sailing Club, Spanish Honor Society, Special Spaces, Theatre Production (including STUNTS).

1 point athletics per season: Badminton, Baseball, Basketball, Bowling, Cross Country, Field Hockey, Football, Golf, Gymnastics, Lacrosse, Soccer, Softball, Swimming/Diving, Tennis, Track & Field (indoor), Track & Field (outdoor), Volleyball, Water Polo, Wrestling.

NOTE: If your DHS extra-curricular is not listed, see Mr. Wolf before including it on your application.
