DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE POLICY

As a recipient of Federal funds, District 113 operates in compliance with the Drug Free School and Communities Act. The Board of Education realizes that both the use and possession of tobacco and the use and unlawful possession of alcohol and other drugs are detrimental to the health and well-being of students. Such use or possession disrupts the school's curricular and extracurricular activities as well as interferes with the education of the user/possessor and others.

Therefore, students are prohibited from any act, attempt or intent to possess, use, obtain, manufacture, sell or distribute any illegal, controlled or intoxicating substance, including alcohol, inhalants, and other drugs, anabolic steroids, or any substance purported to be, or presented as an illegal, controlled or intoxicating substance, or drug paraphernalia on school premises or as part of attendance/participation at any school-sponsored activities. This includes all prescription/non-prescription drugs when such a prescription/non-prescription drug is sold, distributed, possessed, and/or consumed by the student in a manner inconsistent with the prescription and/or prescribed or directed purpose. Possession shall include, but not be limited to, the use of a student's personal clothing, supplies, or vehicle, as well as lockers, desks or other school property. (Board Policy 6999)

SMOKE AND TOBACCO FREE ENVIRONMENT

Students are prohibited from possessing or using tobacco products on school property, in school buildings, in school district sponsored vehicles, and at any school-sponsored activity. "Tobacco products" include but are not limited to cigarette, cigar, pipe, or tobacco in any other form including smokeless tobacco which is any loose, cut, shredded, ground, powdered, compressed, or leaf tobacco that is intended to be placed in the mouth without being smoked.

Deerfield High School Policies and Procedures for Spectrum SPRING FLING

- Guests must complete a guest application form. Forms must be turned in (via e-mail) by Monday, May 12th, 2015
- There is a \$7 Admission Fee to participate in the dance. **THIS ADMISSION FEE IS DUE AT THE DOOR, NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Submit forms to Glorianne Hamm – ghamm@dist113.org
- Unless a guest is a date of a current DHS student and arrives with the DHS student for entrance, guests must have a confirmed advisor/chaperone from their school attending the event. The advisor/chaperone must be present for a guest to be admitted to the dance.
- Once signed, you must turn in the form to the event sponsor before the event occurs. **PLEASE TURN THE FORM IN ADVANCE OF THE DANCE**
- Students must arrive with identification at the event no later than ONE HOUR after the event has officially begun. If a student arrives after this time, he/she will be subject to search and may be administered a breathalyzer test or refused entry.
- Students are not allowed to bring backpacks or bags into the event. An area to hang coats will be available the night of the event.
- Anyone attending the event is expected to dress appropriately. Garments that are see-through, too short, cut low, or expose one's midriff are not acceptable. Undergarments must not be visible. Dress that is considered inappropriate by school personnel will result in the student being sent home.
- All school rules apply to anyone who attends the event. Slam dancing, shoulder riding, mosh pits, grinding, kissing, inappropriate treatment of others, violent behavior, drugs or alcohol use and smoking are not permitted.
- Appropriate Language **MUST** be used at **ALL TIMES** during this event.
