The tournament is on Saturday, May 16, 2015. All teams should plan on arriving at Glenbrook South by 8:30AM, the latest. Please check-in at the head scorers’ table (by the concession stand) or find Head Coach Seong Ha upon arrival, there you will have to submit your team’s roster (please see player eligibility section). If there are any changes for the day, they will be announced at that time. **THERE WILL BE A COACHES MEETING AT 8:40AM BY THE MAIN STADIUM BLACK FENCE NEAR THE TRACK AND GRANDSTAND SIDE**

ENTRY FEE: \$250.00, please send in as soon as possible.

CHECK-IN TIME: Please plan on arriving by **8:30AM**, we need to know teams are present. Warm-up areas are available for teams not participating. Your team may set up camp anywhere except next to the playing field for safety precautions. **Please pick up a large plastic garbage bag at the check-in table**, so that your team may dispose of their garbage during the day. Buses can drop you off in the west parking lot. Buses may also remain in that west parking lot also.

COLORS: We request that each team **bring home and away jerseys**. If you do not have two sets of uniforms, let us know and we will make adjustments. The first team listed on the playing schedule will be the home team.

DURATION OF MATCHES: All games will be **2 x 15** minute halves. Halftime will be a hydration break and quick switch.

SCHEDULE / ROUND ROBIN MATCHES: Teams are divided into three (3) pools of four (4) teams each. Every team will play everyone in their respective pool.

Teams will be awarded:

- Six (6) points for a win,
- Three (3) points for a tie,
- One (1) point for each goals scored up to three (3) goals/points per game, and
- One (1) point for a shutout.

In the event of a tie in overall points in determining advancement to the playoffs, the following procedure will be used:

- Head-to-head contest
- Least goals against
- Most goals scored
- Goal differential
- Coin flip

PLAYOFF ADVANCEMENT: All teams will advance to the playoffs. There will be three (3) playoff divisions used:

- Consolation playoff teams will be on Field #2 – Freshman Practice Field
- Runner-Up playoff teams will be on Field #3 – Varsity / Junior Varsity Practice Field (behind stadium)
- Championship playoff teams will be on Field #1 – Main Stadium Turf Field

The first (1st) place team in each pool along with best second (2nd) place team will advance to the championship bracket on the Main Stadium Turf Field.

The remaining two second (2nd) place teams and the best two third (3rd) place teams will advance to the runner-up bracket on the Varsity / JV Practice Field.

The remaining third (3rd) place team and all the fourth (4th) place teams will advance to the consolation bracket on the Freshman Practice Field.

PENALTY KICKS: In the event of a tie after a playoff game, penalty kicks will be used to determine which team advances to the final game or to determine the bracket champion. Each team will select five (5) players from their roster to shoot penalty kicks. The shooters do not have to be on the field at the end of the game. NFHS penalty kicks will be used. **Therefore, the goalkeeper may NOT move forward at the referee's whistle.**

AWARDS: An award will be presented to each team that wins their respective playoff bracket.

CONCESSIONS: If no rain occurs, there will be a concession stand available this year. If rain does occur, the concession stand will not be available and be closed. We will sell Gatorade, hot dogs, candy, chips, snacks, etc.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY: Only players that have been on your Junior Varsity (JV) team **ALL SEASON** are eligible to play in this tournament. Players that have been on the Varsity team this season or last season, but have not seen much playing time, again **are not allowed to participate in this tournament.** **The spirit of this tournament must be upheld for the standards upon the Central Suburban League (CSL) and the sportsmanship ideals of the NFHS and IHSA.** Head coaches of the respective high schools and Junior Varsity coaches are responsible to monitor this policy to the fullest. Any questions regarding questionable players, will be ruled on by the tournament director, and that decisions will be final.

GENERAL MISCELLANEOUS: No admission will be charged. Outdoor washroom facilities will be available outside the stadium on the south end of the stadium closest to the GBS facility equipment shed. The school will be closed except for emergencies. Coaches should monitor and are responsible for all players and their actions while on the building grounds. **NO BALL GIRLS WILL BE PROVIDED. Each team needs to provide one ball person for each game in which to play the match.** Glenbrook South High School and its girls' soccer program will provide the game balls and corner flags. **Athletic trainers will be on duty throughout the day. The home team will provide game balls!**
